1.03.26 Apologies

- a) Apologies for absence received from Cllr. C.Sangan, Ward Cllr. F.Gourley.

2.03.26 Declaration of Interests

- a) No Interests were declared.

3.07.27Minutes

- a) The minutes of the last Parish Council Meeting and the Annual Parish meeting, held on the 13 May were APPROVED.

4.07.26 The Local Plan and SCCW

- a) Local Plan - Current position (July 2026): The council's official Local Plan website and development timeline now state that the Regulation 19 Draft Local Plan consultation is scheduled for Autumn 2026. No specific start date has yet been published.
- b) SCCW – Ward Cllr MacCabe said that his expectation was that the HE2 option 2 (canal diversions added to allow a 'return to a navigable waterway') will now **not** be included in the next Local Plan iteration.

5.07.26 CBLNR (Camerton Batch Local Nature Reserve)

- a) Information received by the Clerk regarding carbon capture of mature tree at the CBLNR does not appear feasible. The Clerk will explore engaging with the Rural Payments Agency to support CBLNR and report back.

6.07.26 Camerton bus service

- a) WECA Better Buses Consultation: The public consultation closed on 10 May 2026. WECA has not yet published the survey results. However, it looks like 2 bus services may be introduced this Summer 2026 (Bus Service 100 and 768). As soon as we have more information (e.g. route/timetables) it will be posted on the parish website.

8.07.26 Highways and Rights of Ways

- a) The council NOTES that Speed indicator Devices (SIDs) Somerset & Avon Police Commission Police Community Trust are longer accepting grant applications and the Trust is being wound-up, although BANES have been contacted for other funding sources as has the device manufacture, no funding sources were identified. The Council will proceed with the SIDs using its funds if possible. Clerk to check and share costs with council.

9.07.26 Environment

- a) The 160 flowers have delivered and planted in the flower planters and are being maintained via a local contractor. As the weather is exceptionally dry Clerk has been asked to check remaining budget.

10.08.26 Financial aspects

- a) External Audit – To NOTE that the accounts are with the External Auditor (BDO).
b) PUBLIC INSPECTION - The period for the exercise of 30 day public inspection rights is presently ongoing (Monday 10 June 2026 to Friday 21 July 2026) no requests have been received so far.
c) Residents request to fund a Water-butt (100 litres) for the bus stop area on Tunley Hill (est £30-£40) was APPROVED to support the Camerton flower planters. Clerk to notify the resident.
